

## **Policy Statement**

We believe health and hygiene to be of paramount importance and keep abreast of latest advice from Environmental Health Department

Our **Health & Safety Officer, Claire McFadden**, will implement our procedures to maintain an optimal environment in order to support and promote the good health of the children.

## **Procedures**

To ensure the environment is welcoming and to avoid risks, we adhere to the following:

Daily checks for cleanliness and signs of wear & tear/ deterioration of building fabric, resources and equipment.

No smoking, no e-cigarettes or vaping on and around the premises.

Activities provided for the children will take into account children's health, dietary and physical needs.

We will raise awareness of good hygiene practice and healthy living through routines, role modelling, stories and visual prompts.

- Tissues and wipes will be provided at all times.
- Disposable paper towels will be available in the toilet.
- Hands will be washed thoroughly with soap.
- Furniture and resources will be cleaned regularly.
- Toilets will be cleaned daily.
- Disposable gloves and aprons will be used for changing nappies.
- Soiled clothing will be bagged for parents to collect.
- Spillages are cleaned using a mild disinfectant solution.

• Infected toys will be cleaned with disinfectant.
